For the 32 young adults in our **Independent Living and VOCA** supportive housing programs, the family that they've created here, with each other and our staff, is the only family most of them will be celebrating the holiday's with. We want to make this time of year as "homey" as possible for them.

- Movie passes or gift cards for Thanksgiving Day & Christmas Day (Preferred amount: \$30 pp)

For our young people at **Youth Connections** – we are seeing an increase in the number of homeless youths who are coming to our drop-in center. Many are eating their only meal of the day with us. We average 20-25 youth visits per day in the holiday season.
