Monroe Harding has supported Middle Tennessee's foster youth and young adults for over 130 years. Founded in 1893 as an orphanage, we've evolved to meet the changing needs of the community, becoming a vital resource for youth in the foster care system and those transitioning to adulthood.

Since our founding, we've cared for more than 16,000 children who have experienced abuse, abandonment, or neglect. Today, we provide a healing community where youth and families move beyond trauma to find hope.

Our mission is carried out through four core programs:

- **Foster Care:** Recruiting, training, and supporting loving foster families.
- **Supportive Housing:** Offering safe, affordable housing and life skills coaching for young adults.
- **Education & Career Readiness:** Connecting youth to education, job skills, and meaningful career opportunities.
- **Therapy & Healing:** Providing trauma-informed therapy and mental health support.

At Monroe Harding, we believe every young person deserves the opportunity to thrive. Our programs empower youth with the resources, support, and connections they need to succeed.
