About Monroe Harding


Monroe Harding has served foster youth and young adults in Middle Tennessee for more than 130 years. Founded in 1893 as an orphanage, Monroe Harding began by providing a safe and nurturing environment for children in need. Over time, our mission has evolved to meet the changing needs of the community, and today we serve as a vital resource for youth navigating the foster care system and the transition into adulthood.

Since our founding, Monroe Harding has cared for more than 16,000 children who have experienced abuse, abandonment, or neglect. Today, we are a healing community where youth and families move beyond trauma and begin to experience stability, opportunity, and hope. With the right support, encouragement, and resources, young people are able to grow beyond their circumstances and build brighter futures.

We fulfill this mission through three key programs that support young people currently in, or transitioning from, the foster care system:

 **Foster Care:** Recruiting, training, and supporting foster families who provide safe, stable, and nurturing homes.

 **Supportive Housing:** Providing safe, supportive housing and life skills coaching for young adults transitioning to independence.

 **Education & Career Readiness:** Connecting youth to educational opportunities, workforce development, and meaningful career pathways.
